With one of the projects our "Better Together program" she had the assistance of council, local business as well as law enforcement in our community. Even today every Tuesday is labelled "Better Together" Tuesday where most folks in town wear their better together t-shirts.

Our community got on Board with the Better Together program, she gathered a committee including myself and local law enforcement. T-shirts were ordered and sold through a local business and distributed to the public, if one person or a business wanted to donate funds for t-shirts monies were collected and t-shirts were purchased for the schools, as we dressed entire schools with t-shirts through donations. We held weekly bbq's where different groups volunteered their time to work the bbq, funds raised through the bbq's were used to put on local free events such as our "Funday Sunday" in our park including bouncy castles. Twice this year we also held a movie in the park again free for community folks to come with their family attend. Monies also were utilized to provide craft projects for all ages, including chalk for sidewalks. Last Christmas she also organized a scavenger

hunt to be competed by driving around town in your car looking for items or completing the many puzzles/quizzes.. Right now she has stuffed every town mailbox with a poppy on a piece of paper and similar to our paper hearts in our window when the pandemic began, we will place our paper poppy's in our window to show support. If that wasn't enough there was also online bingo for those to tune in to. She consistently stayed in tune with everyone by daily posts on facebook, even if only to tell a corny joke or two.
